### REPRESENTATIVE CASES

Representation of inventor and former supplier of proprietary offshore oil and gas tool in an intellectual property and business dispute against a former service company customer that reverse engineered the tool to create a competing product. Obtained jury verdict awarding \$4.95 million for patent infringement, willful and malicious trade secret misappropriation, bad faith breach of contract, fraud, and unfair trade practices. Judgment further awarded permanent injunction and an additional \$1.5 million in attorneys' fees and interest. Lead counsel in one of the two appeals of the judgment, both of which resulted in the judgment being affirmed.
